## The AWE (Aphasia Walkthrough Evaluation) Method Method

- 1. Select 3 typical tasks to perform.
- 2. There should be two people doing the evaluation: one person doing the walkthrough and the other is a scribe.
- 3. Video the session.
- 4. Walkthrough, and talk through the task, step by step. At each step /screen:
  - i) make a note of the step and describe what happens.
  - ii) discuss which guidelines are conformed/not conformed to.
  - iii) use the guideline colour scheme to highlight the notes
  - iv) make typical/likely mistakes; explore what happens if a mistake is made.
- 5. Consider all pathways through the site/program.
- 6. At the end: collate an overall summary from the notes re how/where the site conforms/ does not conform to each guideline.
- 7. Get an informal opinion from an aphasia expert who has experience of people with aphasia using the site/program. What is their view? Contrast this with 6.
